## EDITO

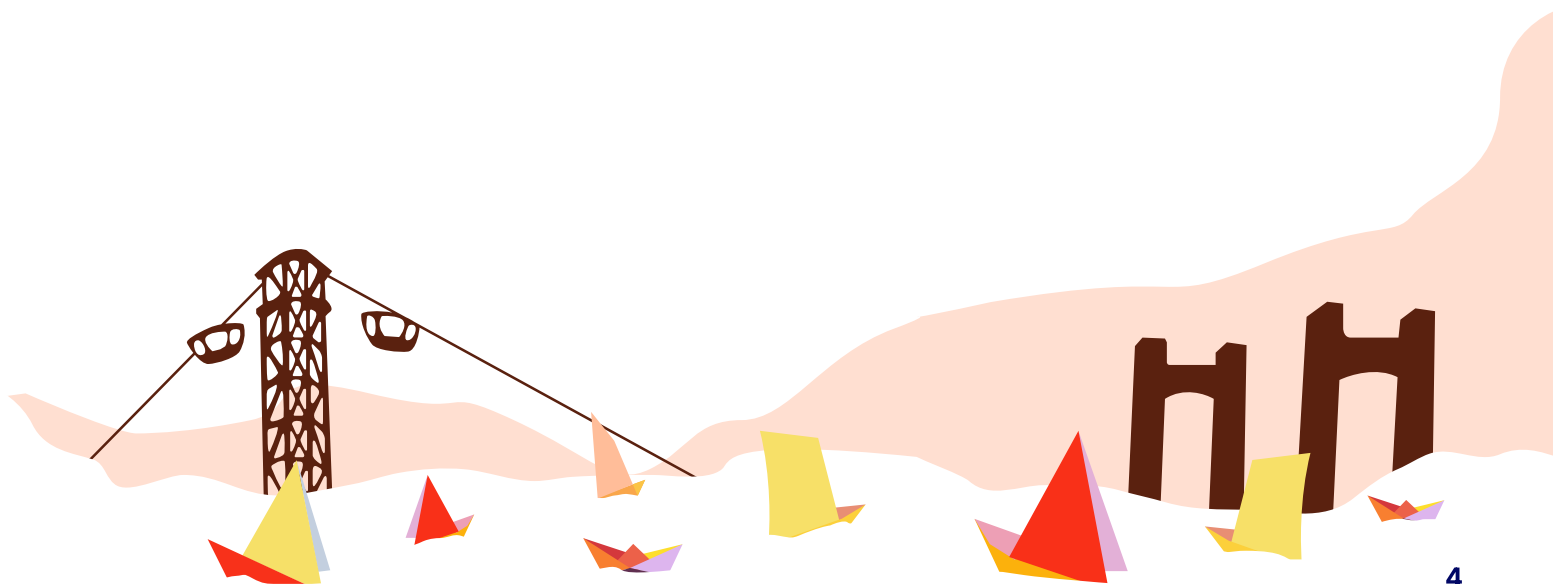

# SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

## VIGIE MER

As the security level has been raised to its highest state by the French government this year ('urgence attentat' attack emergency), we have put in a huge amount of work to ensure the good course of the festival.

Please find below all the sailing instructions to ensure that everybody is safe on the water and on the quayside.

## SAILING TIMES

Boats are allowed to be out on the water between 9am and 10pm.

On the 14th and 17th of July, sailing time is extended until 00:30 am.

Except during those times, boats are not allowed to be out on the water within the scope of the Fêtes.

## VIGIE MER

Each boat movement is coordinated by our "Vigie Mer". It may prevent access to the Fêtes' port area for any boat whose entry would likely compromise the smooth running of the event, in-port manoeuvres, security or the environment.

It is forbidden for boats to navigate in 3 zones :

- the zone to the West of the military port (marked on the dock),
- the exit from the commercial port via the eastern channel,
- the port zone to the East of the eastern channel.



## ALL DEPARTURES

must be requested to the Vigie Mer, preferably by text message, or alternatively via WhatsApp or via VHF on channel 06.

You will get a text with the number when you get in Brest.

## ALL RETURNS

## REMINDER OF THE VHF CHANNELS

Several on-the-water crafts are tasked with monitoring activity on the water. They patrol the area constantly and monitor the VHF channels.

**06** : Brest Organisation - Indicatif : VIGIE MER

**16** : Emergency - Indicatif : MAY DAY, PAN PAN, SECURITE

**12** : Harbour office Port de commerce

**09** : Harbour office Marina du Château

## ON THE WATER SECURITY

Various emergency resources are deployed throughout the Fêtes area, both at sea and dockside. They are made up of both volunteers from specialist associations and professionals, and they are managed from a Multi-Service Control Station (PCMS). The official organisation's RIBs positioned in the channels are tasked with screening traffic. They communicate to boats who can access the area or not.

Outside the harbour (the festival area), emergency procedures remain the same as usual.

### Dockside safety

Members of the Organisation are in attendance dockside during the day and can direct you towards the first-aid posts.

At night, security staff will be doing rounds across the entire Festival area. In the event of an emergency, dial the usual numbers opposite.

# BASIC RULES

---

## Reminders

### SPEED LIMIT



Boat speed must be reasonable and is restricted inside the harbour area.

### FLAGS



The boat's national flag and the Brest 2024 flag must be displayed throughout the duration of the Fêtes.

Personal tenders are not permitted.

### FENDERS



When sailing, do remember to bring in your fenders for the photos.

### USE OF THE ON-BOARD TOILETS IS FORBIDDEN



### MOORING ZONES



Any change is subject to the authorisation of the body regulating the stretch of water. Any permutations in mooring positions within the same zone are subject to the skippers' good seamanship and the latter are responsible for such a move.

### SHIP REPAIRS



Maintenance operations and repairs to boats are subject to the authorisation of the Régie Mer (Maritime Management).

### REMAIN IN CONTACT



All the boats left dockside without a crew aboard must clearly display the contact details of the person in charge (name and telephone). A security/safety check will be carried out on the crew's return.

### DISEMBARKATION OF PASSENGERS



All those on professional boats or sailboats wishing to disembark within the scope of the Fêtes must have an access badge (Crew bracelet or ticket to go ashore).

### KNIVES AND GLASSES SHALL REMAIN ON BOARD



### ON-BOARD BARBECUES ARE FORBIDDEN



# ON-THE-WATER PROGRAM

---

## Sailing program

The whole team of Brest 2024 has planned plenty of highlights for your boats, so that every flotilla can have fun and show their sailing skills to the audience ashore.

### **Please find below the daily program :**

- **Flotilla dedicated sailings** accross Brest bay (picnic destinations, coastal navigations, little regattas...). Each involved flotilla will receive its schedule on Whatsapp and in the Crew area.
- **Vire-vire** within the festival will start at 1:30 pm and a second one at 3:00 pm. Each vire-vire will enhance the flotilla of the day according to the program of the Fêtes.
- **Specific shows** of one or two hours will put the qualities of your boat in the spotlight in front of the audience.
- **Scull championship** : every evening, from 6:30 pm to 7:30 pm you are invited to demonstrate you sculling abilities in front of le Quai Malbert. Two boats will be at your disposal for the runs and a great final will be organised on the 17th of July.

### **Highlights :**

Les Fêtes opening will be given by the Abeille Bourbon's siren on Friday the 12th of July at 10:00 am. You are all invited to join the signal with your own foghorn !

On the 13th of July, you are welcome to sail all together in the Bay and discover the surprise route we have prepared for you.

Helicopter and life saving showcases will take place several times during the Fêtes. You will obviously be informed so you can secure your position and enjoy the show.

On the 18th, the Brest-Douarnenez Parade, organised by la Région Bretagne will allow each and everyone of you to experience right from the inside an extraordinary sailing moment in la Mer d'Iroise.

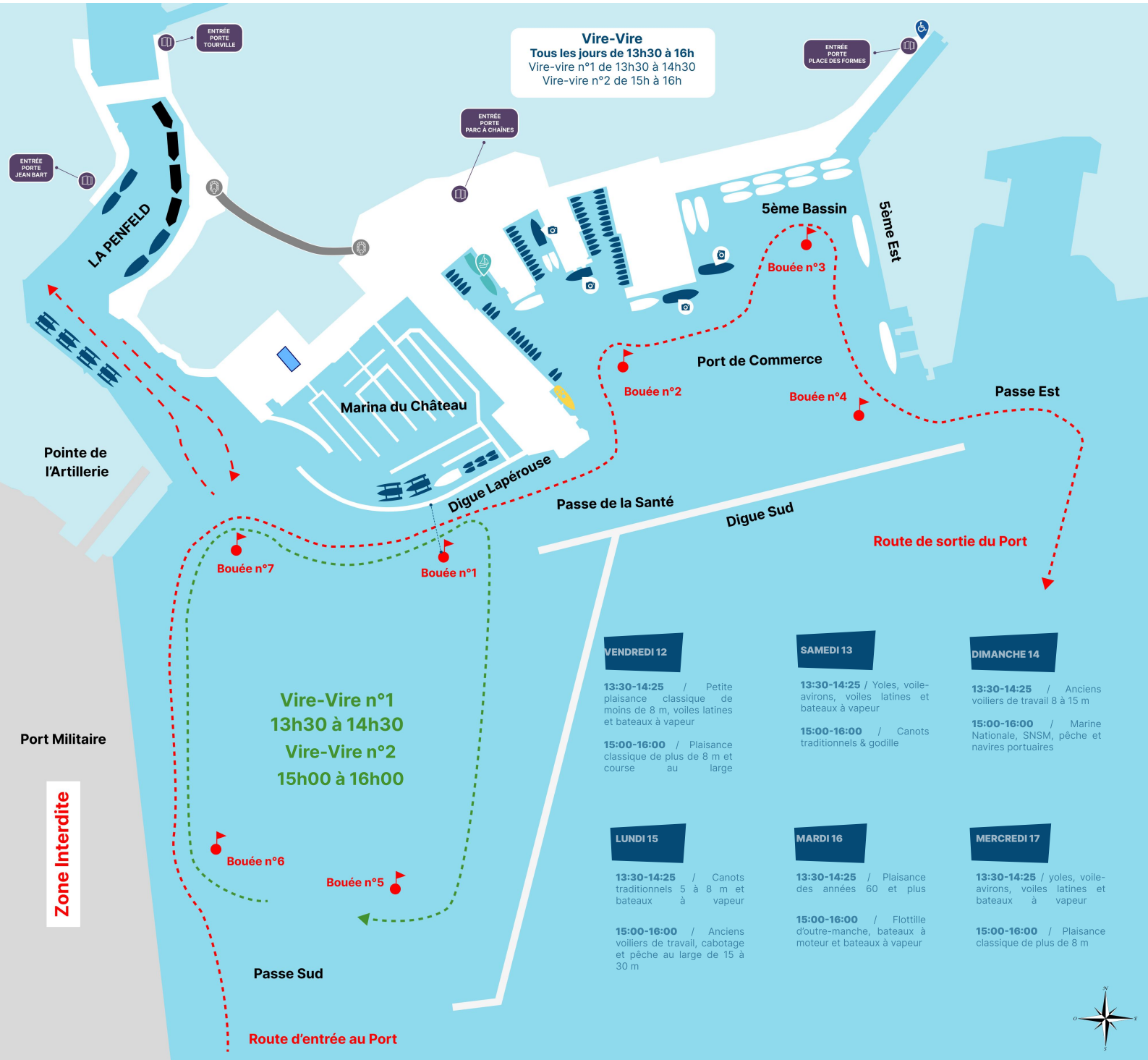

**Flotilla gets into formation** : 10:30 pm. Start at 11pm - Final at 00:00 (duration 1h)

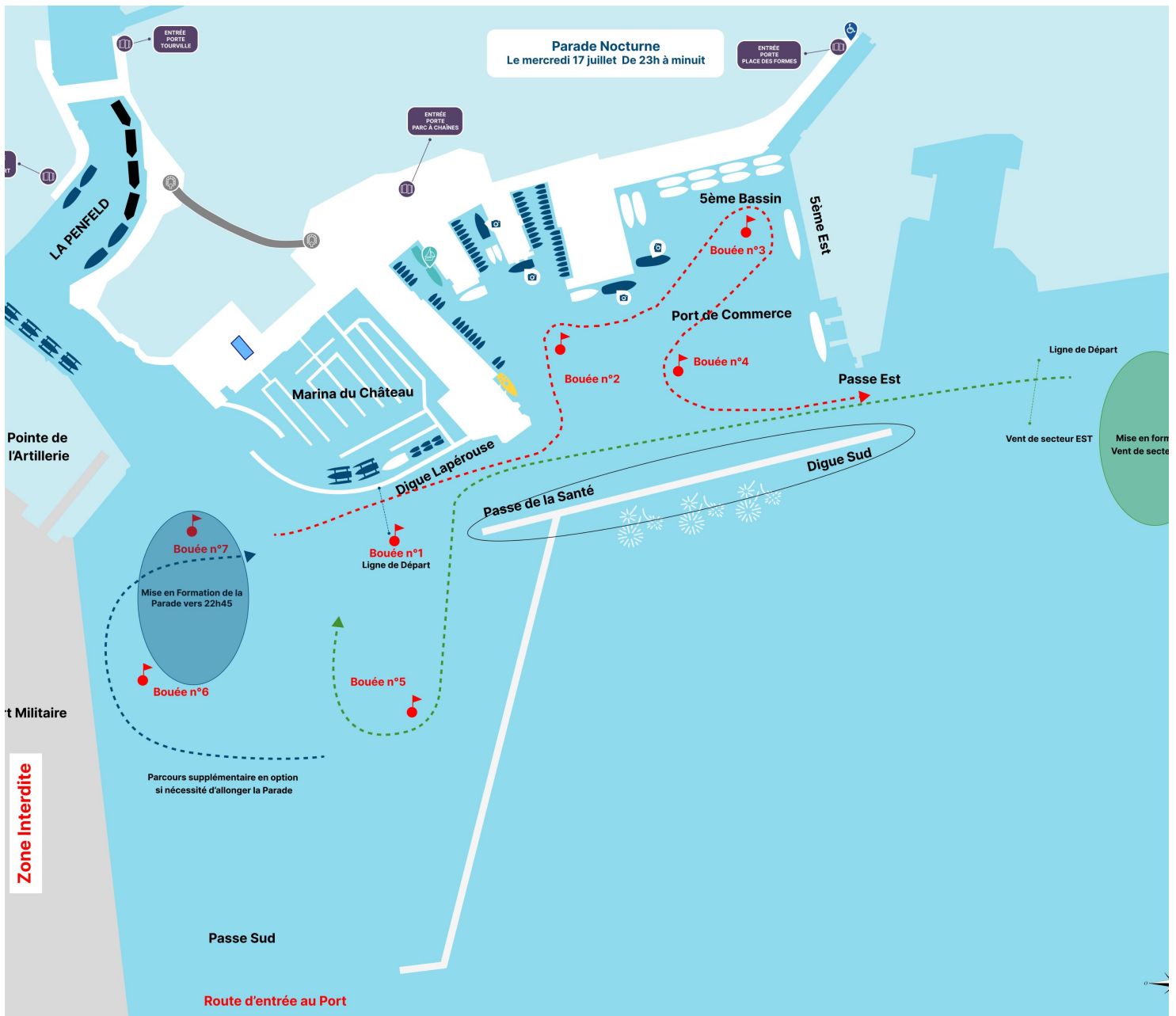
Subjected to weather conditions.

Information at the Crew space (Espace équipages).

Nautical info and instructions via VHF channel.

All boats are under engine, with sails up, at constant speed. Speed is imposed by the head vessel, 3 knots. 2 full turns of the "port de commerce" outside of the buoys and stop in the middle of the harbour. Lights out, blow of horn by the Abeille Bourbon, taken over by all the boats. End of the show.

Rowing boats and small crafts will receive specific instructions. In all cases, they will have to deviate from the path of the big ones as soon as they no longer hold the required speed.



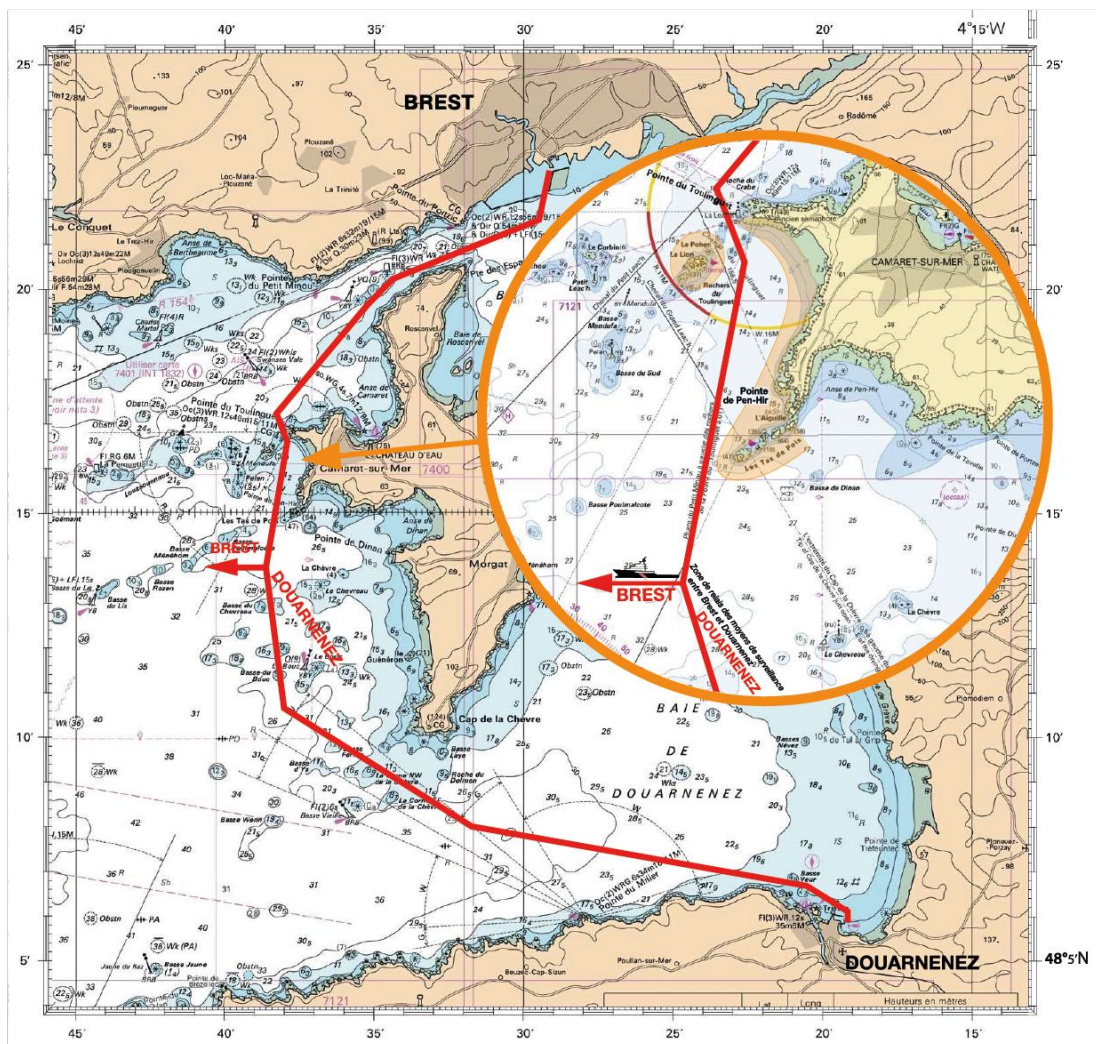


# PARADE OF THE 18TH OF JULY
