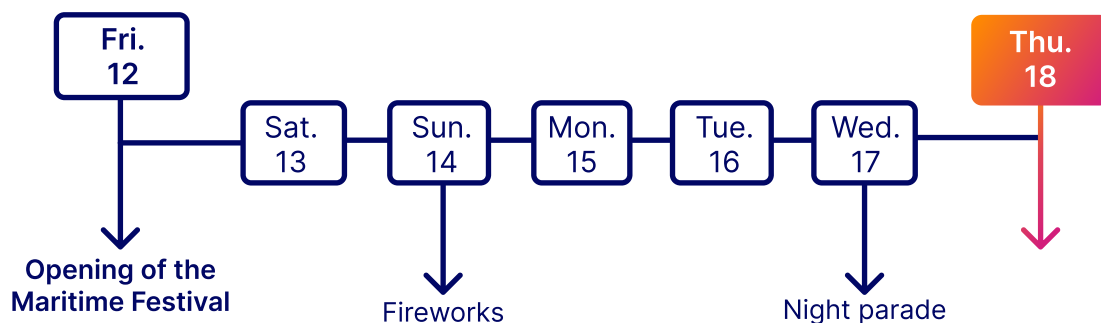

IMMIGRATION FORMALITIES

If you come from a country outside the Schengen area and did not complete immigration formalities before coming to Brest, it is essential that you go to Customs office to get your passport stamped.

The Customs office is located within the heart of the event, and opens from 8.30am to 3.30pm.
